Cromadex Acid Etch Aerosol

Product Description	Cromadex Acid Etch is a high quality fast dry spraying primer, offering excellent adhesion on many difficult to coat substrates, including aluminium, alloy, stainless steel and zintec. Acid Etch contains active rust prevention pigments, is very fast drying and can be overcoated with most Cromadex topcoats.		
Usage	Before use, carefully read the directions on the packaging and act accordingly.		
Pre-Treatment	The surface should be clean, dry and free of grease. Remove loose old lacquer and rust and sand the surface.		
Treatment	The surface should be clean, dry and free of grease. The best processing temperature is between15 to 25°C. Before use, shake the aerosol for 2 minutes and spray a sample. Distance to the surface to be treated approximately 25 to 30 centimetres.		
	Apply the Acid Etch in several thin layers. Before applying the next layer, again shake the aerosol. After drying, a primer and a top coat can be applied.		
	After use, to clean the valve (turn aerosol upside down and press the nozzle for approximately 5 seconds).

	The drying time depends on the ambient temperature, the humidity of the air and the thickness of the film applied.
